From Concord to Pangburn: Timothy and Sarah Miller, & Luke Quattlebaum

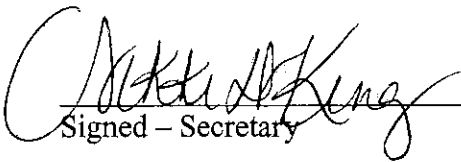
To White Co Central from Pangburn: J.C. (John) and Emery Hollis

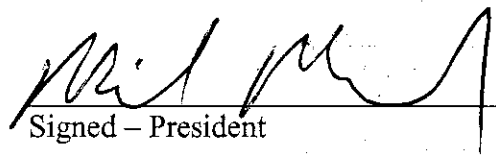
To Searcy from Pangburn: Alexis and Pierce Russell
