MINUTES

Mr. Rolland recommended that the Board approve the minutes from the regular February board meeting. Trey Reaper moved to approve the recommendation, Lori Huggins seconded, motion carried 5-0 (5:02 p.m.).

FINANCIAL REPORTS

Mr. Rolland recommended that the Board approve the financial reports from February. Nikki King moved to approve the recommendation, Will Smith seconded. Motion carried 5-0 (5:04 p.m.).

DISTRICT

Digital Learning Plan

Mr. Rolland recommended that the Board approve the Pangburn School District Digital Learning Plan for the school year 2022. The District will partner with the Wilbur D. Mills Co-op to provide instruction for K-8 students using Pearson Education Services and 9-12 grade students by using Virtual Arkansas. Trey Reaper moved to approve the recommendation, Nikki King seconded. Motion passed 5-0 (5:13 p.m.).

21st Century Grant

Mr. Rolland recommended that the Board approve the hourly rates for employees working after school in the 21st Century program. This recommendation is to retroactively approve the rates back to August of 2019. Will Smith moved to approve, Lori Huggins seconded. Motion carried 5-0 (5:14 p.m.).

Emergency Management Participation

Mr. Rolland recommended that the Board adopt a resolution regarding White County Hazard Mitigation Plan. The actual resolution is attached to this original document in the administration office and is available upon request. Lori Huggins moved to approve the recommendation, Will Smith seconded. Motion carried 5-0 (5:15 p.m.)

School Board Election

Mr. Rolland recommended that the Board approve that the annual school board election be held at one site for in person voting and that site will be at the Pangburn City Hall on May 18, 2021.

Trey Reaper moved to approve the recommendation, Nikki King seconded. Motion carried 5-0 (5:20 p.m.).

Proposed Budget

Mr. Rolland recommended that the Board approve the Proposed Budget of Expenditures beginning July 1, 2022 to and including June 30, 2023. Will Smith moved to approve the recommendation, Trey Reaper seconded. Motion carried 5-0 (5:21 p.m.).

Resolution for employee's family members to subcontract services

Mr. Rolland recommended that the Board approve the following family members of employees to do subcontract work for the district:

Daycare Incentive

Mr. Rolland recommended that the Board approve a change in the wording of the daycare attendance incentive policy to say, "The daycare attendance incentive will be obtained by an employee not taking a sick day during the pay period".

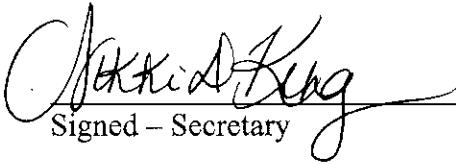
Hiring

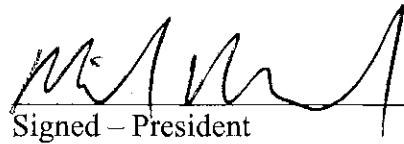
